Temporary Work Programs

In a rural farming community, environmental crises--such as deforestation and severe, dry conditions--only exacerbate the already existing economic crisis in Haiti.

No gardens + no available work = no income for families

The Temporary Work programs allow Lemuel to address both the urgent and the long-term community needs at the same time. Representatives from area families are hired for temporary periods in a project that is beneficial to the entire community, such as a water hole or a road. The income that the families receive is often the only thing that sustains them through devastating drought and unending economic recession. Plus, the future of the population slowly becomes more secure as water is collected, roads are improved, and other aspects of the community are developed.
